From airport to convention (20 to 40 minutes, depending on traffic and type of transport)

The Acropolis has a total surface of 38 000 square meters (409 028 square feet). We will be using 16 rooms with capacities ranging from 30 to 750 people (total capacity: 3686). In addition, there are three auditoriums, one holding 300 persons, another for 740, and the largest 2500.

The Hugos and the Masquerade would be held in the largest of the three

auditoriums mentioned above.

There are many restaurants within walking distance of the convention center, including in the old town, covering a wide variety of world cuisine.
